

## OVERVIEW FOR FOOD SERVICE WORKERS

For a school to participate in the *Network*, a Food Service Worker must agree to be part of the Leadership Team. Schools will not receive a *Network* award without the participation of a Food Service Worker.

By signing the Leadership Team Contract Agreement, the Food Service Worker agrees to support the Lead Teacher and the school's *Network* activities as described in the Action Plan/Harvest of the Month Only Program, NAC Program, Nurse Program, or Modified Program. See the Lead Teacher for more details regarding your school's Action Plan.

- The term “Food Service Worker” is a term used by the *Network* to include all benefited Cafeteria Personnel, including but not limited to Cafeteria Managers (School Food Service Managers and Satellite Food Service Managers).
- Food Service Workers are responsible for working with the Lead Teacher to place Harvest of the Month (HOTM) orders monthly and faxing in the completed order forms to the *Network* office.
- Food Service Workers who are part of an Action Award school may be asked to participate in other activities including working with the Lead Teacher to help procure food and supplies from the cafeteria and helping coordinate other activities.
- Food Service Workers will receive a copy of their school's budget. He or she should review the budget lines pertaining to the cafeteria: food orders, overtime and/or additional time compensation for cafeteria staff.
- Food Service Workers are responsible for the information in this section and *Network for a Healthy California—LAUSD Manual for Food Services 2009–2010*.
